SHARING CHRISTIAN'S JOURNEY by Marisa Garcia, Christian's Mom

For the most part, our life was fairly normal. (During a pandemic, it was as normal as it could get, at least.) School was out for the summer, we were enjoying a day at the beach, and then our life was flipped upside down one random Monday afternoon. Our son Christian turned 6 years old, proudly graduated kindergarten, and was living a happy, healthy life. The night we came back from the beach, he first mentioned a pain behind his ear. After careful inspection, a large bump behind his earlobe became obvious and concerning. The following week, we visited his pediatrician twice, along with an urgent care doctor, and we didn't get any answers. The left side of Christian's face became swollen, and that's when we made

the decision to go to the emergency room for scans.

On Monday, June 14, 2021, Christian, my 4-year old daughter Camila, and I arrived at the emergency room. Several doctors came in to inspect Christian, but I never allowed my worry to get ahead of me. Eventually, what I assumed were two doctors came in and asked to meet with me outside of the room. While a Child Life Specialist stayed in the room to occupy the kids, I followed the doctors to a waiting room. As we entered, they began moving chairs to situate our seating, and it was at that very moment I knew this was serious. Never in my wildest imagination would I ever think our reality was about to change like it did. All I remember hearing were the words, "It's a tumor and we believe it to be cancer."



Cancer. You see it in the world around you, but happening to your own child? How? That was just the beginning. It took another week of tests to reveal that not only was a baseball-sized tumor growing in Christian's neck, but the cancer had spread throughout his whole body - his arms, legs, pelvis, spine, and bone marrow. Soon after, Christian was officially diagnosed with Stage IV Rhabdomyosarcoma.

Another facet to navigate, and one of the hardest for me, was being away from our other children. In a matter of a couple days, Christian started the most aggressive chemotherapy in his 52-week treatment at MD Anderson Children's Cancer Hospital.

Somehow, there was beauty in confusion, heartache, and pain. Our family's support system was strong, and everyone came to bat for us. Immediately after the doctors explained what we were facing, I posted our story to social media. Typically, I am not someone to post a lot, but I felt the need to rally everyone for prayer, and quite frankly there was no time to waste. I understand people trying to privately navigate a situation like this, but looking back, I could not have walked this journey without the help of the village around us. Family, friends, strangers, and churches were praying for us, and we could feel every word. That support is what got us through the dark times. That, and our faith.



Among the support, Candlelighters was the first organization to reach out to us. Although their Parent Consultants couldn't be in the hospital to meet us in-person because of COVID-19, they reached out immediately and let us know they were there to listen, vent, provide financial assistance; they were there for not only Christian, but for our whole family. Candlelighters provided events and programs and an outlet we needed to bring the whole family back together again and enjoy life. You can never remove yourself from the diagnosis, but you can let yourself enjoy the small things you previously took for granted. I never asked why this had to happen to our son, because that's something we will never get an answer to. I told myself, "I don't know how we got here, but we're here, and we will continue to walk through this with faith and with the people who stay along for the ride." Thankfully, Candlelighters' motto is – once a Candlelighters family, always a Candlelighters family.

Fast forward 2.5 months into treatment, and his oncologist declared Christian a "miracle" after scans revealed that all of his cancer was gone and the tumor was dead. It was another indescribable feeling and a rollercoaster of emotions. Christian, now 7 years old, rang the bell and completed treatment on May 23, 2022!

Since becoming a Candlelighters family, we have been able to enjoy family time at a Houston Astros game, attended their Virtual Camp CLIFF in 2021, and joined the festivities at their Fall Festival Drive Thru and their Merry Mingle event with Santa at the end of last year! So far this year, we received the Bell Ringing In A Box kit for Christian's end-of-treatment celebration, my husband and I felt the love on Mother's Day and Father's Day, we partied at Summer Surprises, and Christian got the honor of throwing out the first pitch at the Sugar Land Space Cowboys game! I even shared about our journey on a local podcast with Candlelighters staff. While we never thought we'd be in this childhood cancer "club", we're glad we've found this group and all the people we've met along the way.

After losing their mother, Joyce, to a long, hardfought battle with cancer, they decided it was time to "fight back." In 2009, Team Reloyce was created and what started out as a small fundraiser in their backyard has turned in to a community-wide annual event in their hometown of Moulton, Texas. It is their goal to fight this awful disease and to help ease the burden of those currently on a cancer journey. Their efforts have now blossomed into the Weekend of Hope where they host a 2-day event to raise money for organizations supporting cancer patients.

CANDLELIGHTERS CHILDHOOD CANCER FAMILY ALLIANCE'S MISSION IS TO PROVIDE EMOTIONAL, EDUCATIONAL, AND PRACTICAL SUPPORT TO CHILDREN WITH CANCER AND THEIR FAMILIES.

Candlelighters began in 1989 with two parent support groups from the Texas Medical Center: one at Texas Children's Cancer Center and one at MD Anderson Children's Cancer Hospital. The parent group at Texas Children's Cancer Center sought formal incorporation, and in 1993 Candlelighters was legally formed. In the fall of 1993, they invited the parent group from the MD Anderson Children's Cancer Hospital to join them and the two organizations merged into one. The Parent Consultant Program was developed to directly meet the needs of families at the treatment centers and to inform them of potential resources. Our programs and services extend beyond the hospital walls with our Family Camp, Adopt-A-Family, Fall Festival, Candlelighters Newsletter, and other special events. Over the years, we have learned how critically valuable it is for our Parent Consultants to be able to directly impact families through emotional support, parking assistance, meal passes, gas cards, and more. It is our greatest honor and privilege to bring this type of comfort and hope to childhood cancer families.
