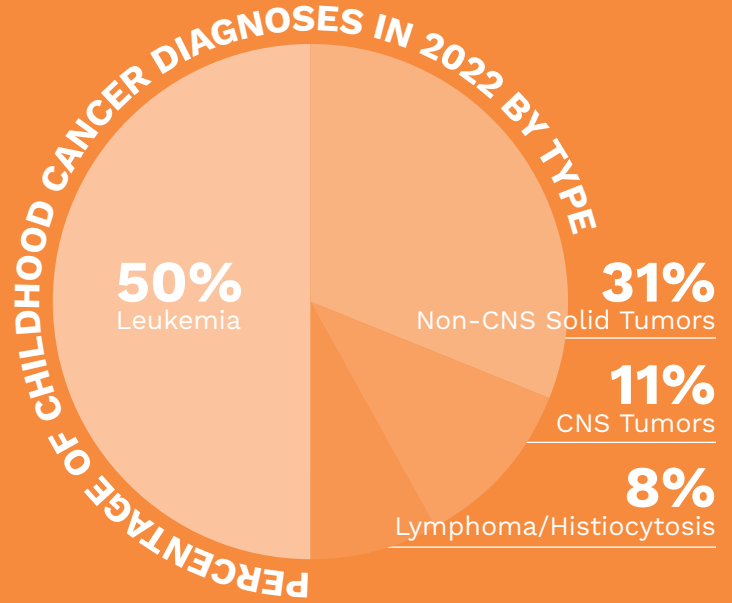
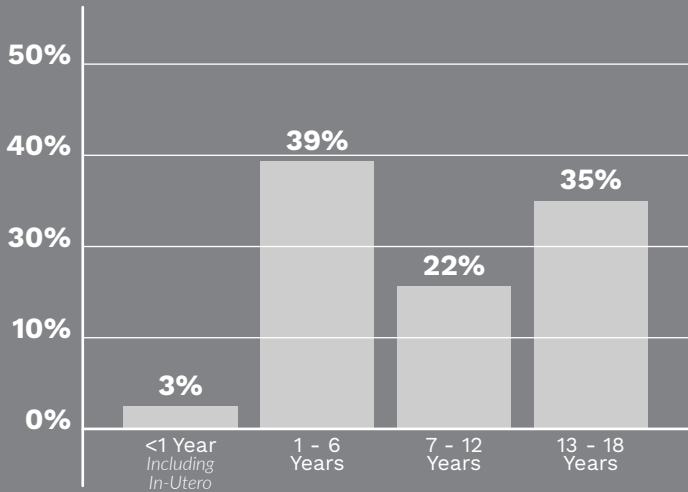

Percentage of Childhood Cancer Diagnoses in 2022 by Age



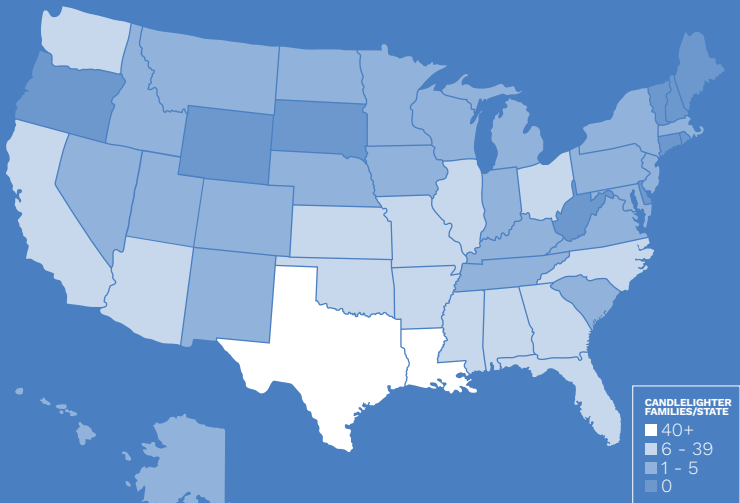

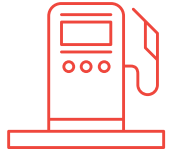

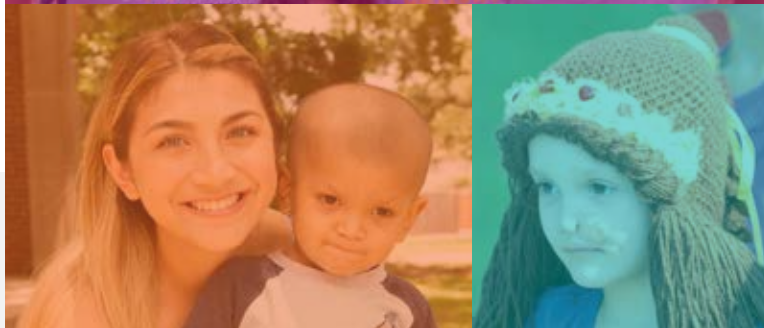
